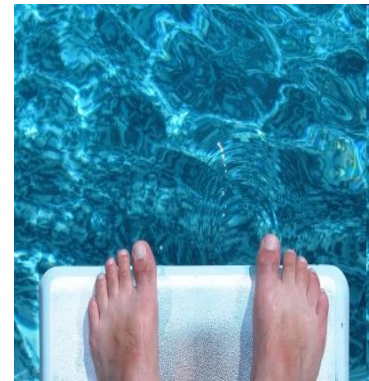

and to contribute to their communities”**

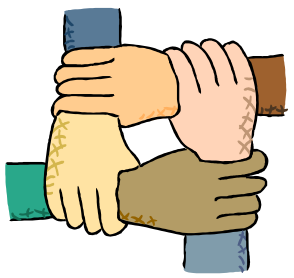


# Model



- network of people living in the same community
- members encouraged to support each other
- **Community Living Worker** living locally provides
  - support with personal issues, tasks
  - facilitation of mutual support, community connection, citizenship

# Support & Facilitation



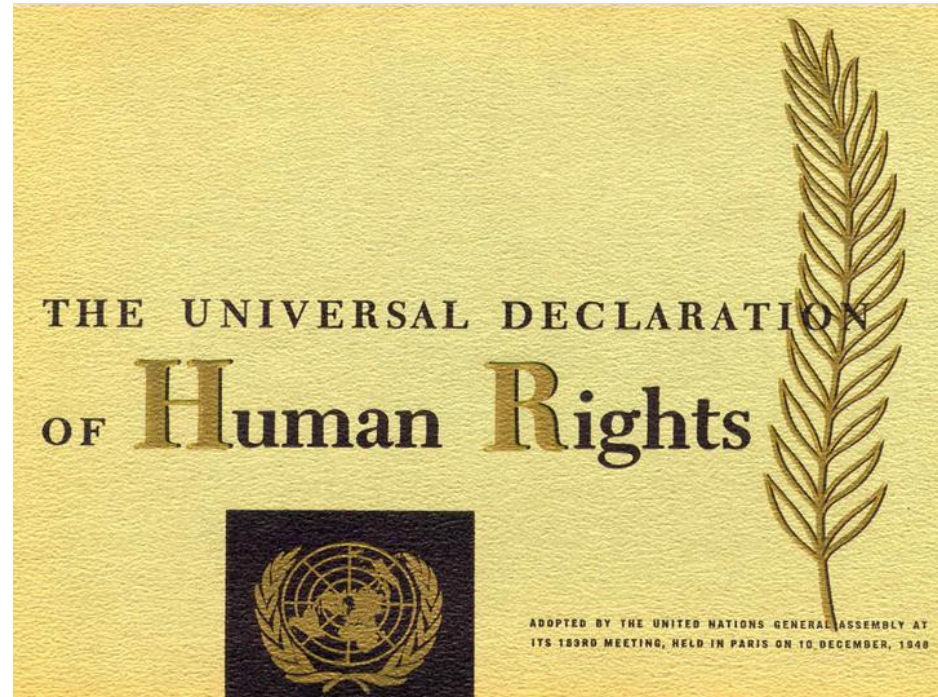
- **flexible** and **negotiated** between members and worker
- provided at **different times** of day/days of week depending on members' needs
- members encouraged to support one another
- support levels can be increased at short notice to meet crises as they occur

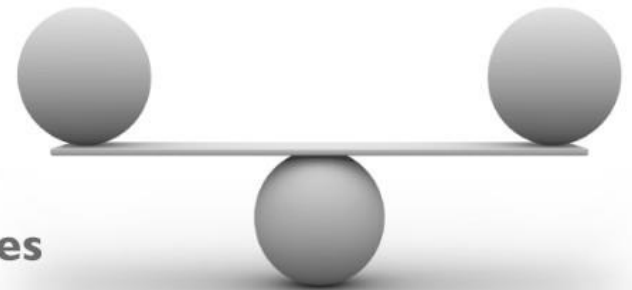

# Principles

- **people can do lots of things for themselves**
- **people can support each other**
- **people require support when they need it but not when they don't**
- **workers should be professional but also neighbours**
- **people don't need specialist services for all their needs**
- **people should aspire to ordinary housing in the community with full tenant rights and all the responsibilities that go with this**

# the essence of social networks

- “member-led” – **Developing Skills in Active Citizenship**
- they enable opportunities for **personal development**
  - “being stretched out of your comfort zone: it helps you grow”
  - “roller coaster: a bit scary but you want more”



# the essence of social networks

- they are **less costly** than other forms of public provision
- they provide **early warning** of crisis
- they **prevent isolation** and problems of loneliness and associated impact on health and wellbeing



# the essence of social networks

- **rather than** “I need this from you”.....  
**networks encourage** “this is the way I want to live my life with your support”
- **networks enable members to offer friendship and support as well as receive it boosting self esteem and confidence**
