### Model





- network of people living in the same community
- members encouraged to support each other
- Community Living Worker living locally provides
  - support with personal issues, tasks
  - facilitation of mutual support, community connection, citizenship



## **Support & Facilitation**









- flexible and negotiated between members and worker
- provided at different times of day/days of week depending on members' needs
- members encouraged to support one another
- support levels can be increased at short notice to meet crises as they occur





# **Principles**

- people can do lots of things for themselves

- workers should be professional but also neighbours
- people don't need specialist services for all their needs
- people should aspire to ordinary housing in the community with full tenant rights and all the responsibilities that go with this

- "member-led" Developing Skills in Active
